Registration Deadline: Monday, August 5th at 5:00 pm, or the first 11 paid registrations per league.

Registration Fee: \$350 per team - 11 games guaranteed.

Out-of-County Teams: Registration for out-of-county teams will be accepted on August 6, if space available in the division.

Captain's Meeting: Wednesday, August 7 at 5:30 pm at Watauga Community Recreation Center (231 Complex Drive, Boone)

Tentative Start Date: Week of August 12

Game Locations: Complex 2 & 3 Softball Fields - MLK Jr Street, Boone

Eligibility: Players must be residents of Watauga County or a full-time students at an accredited school located in Watauga County. Players who work in Watauga County, but do not reside in Watauga County are eligible to join a team with an additional \$25 per player fee. Participants must be 16 years of age or older to be eligible to participate.

Abbreviated League Rules and Regulations:

- ASA Certified bats are the only legal bat
- Game start times between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm
- 60 minute time limit on games
- Uniforms are NOT required
- Hit your own ASA approved 12" COR .52, 300 Compression ball
- 1 ball, 1 strike count on all batters to begin at bat
- No Tobacco and No Alcohol Policy strictly enforced.

Specific Co-ed League Rules and Regulations:

- Teams must have 10 players to start (may start with 12 two extra hitters).
- Batting order must start with a female then alternate male and female until order is complete.
- Team may play with more females than males.
- An 11" COR .52, 300 compression ASA Certified ball may be used for female batters. Male batters must hit a 12" COR .52, 300 compression ASA Certified ball.
- Male batters are limited to SINGLE WALL, ASA certified aluminum or wood bats.
- Female batters may hit any certified ASA Bat.
- If a male batter gets a base on balls without being thrown a strike, then a female batter has the option of hitting or receiving an automatic walk.
