- 1. - 8. State Programs Update: Elise McLaughlin reported the following updates:
  - Fall Meeting registration is open until September 30.
  - The Foundation has limited funding for districts to purchase equipment to rent out to landowners. Discussion followed about possibly purchasing a roller crimper to encourage cover crops. Technician Woodie will ask Michelle Kasey about cost and budget to see if district could afford the 30% match. Discussion followed about hosting a booth at Farm City Banquet and including a list of equipment available to rent.
  - Supervisor reappointment must be submitted to the Division through FormSite by October 31.

- 9. Administrative Update: Technician Woodie shared the following updates:
  - Michelle Kasey coordinated 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Environmental Field Days, held September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> at Valle Crucis Park. They were very successful. Supervisor Hanifan volunteered both days.
  - Michelle Kasey helped with the Ashe County Environmental Field Day, September 10 at New River State Park, and she will assist at the Wilkes County Field Day on October 3.
  - Poster and Speech Contests will be announced in schools on October 1. Speech Contests will be held December 12; board members will be needed for judging.
