The **Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC)** has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals. The JCPC anticipates Raise the Age Expansion funds from the NC Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice, Community Programs section in the amount stated above to fund and/or expand the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state **fiscal year 2019-2020** beginning on, or after, **July 1, 2019**. The use of these Raise the Age Expansion funds in this county do not require a **local match for this year ONLY**. These expansion funds are an addition to the funds previously allocated in the amount of \$114,285.00.

The JCPC will consider proposals for the following needed programs:

Proposed program services should target the following risk factors for delinquency or repeat delinquency:

Substance Use/Abuse School Behavior Problems Relationships with Peers Parental Supervision

Programs should address the following concerns as reported in the Needs Assessments for adjudicated youth:

Peer Domain: Peer Relationships
Individual Domain: Substance Use Abuse/Neglect History Mental Health Needs
Family Domain: Family Supervision Skills Conflict in the Home Family Substance Abuse Family Criminality
School Domain: School Behavior Problems

Applicants are being sought that are able to address items below:

1. Program services compatible with research that are shown to be effective with juvenile offenders.
2. Program services are outcome-based.
3. The program has an evaluation component.
4. Program services detect gang participation and divert individual, if applicable.

Local public agencies, 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations and local housing authorities are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the above elements.
