










## GUIDELINES FOR RECYCLING AT WATAUGA COUNTY CONVENIENCE CENTERS

MATERIAL	ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING	ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED
 <b>GLASS</b>	Clear, brown and green glass containers. Please rinse and separate by color.	No glass from windows, baking dishes or drinking glasses.
 <b>METAL</b>	Tin cans, aluminum cans, foil and all metal jar and bottle lids. Please empty and rinse all containers.	No paint, pesticide or aerosol cans, metal strapping or propane cylinders.
 <b>PLASTICS</b>	Includes all plastic bottles and all plastics #1 and #2, all colors accepted. <b>Plastic bottles are now banned from NC landfills.</b>	<b>NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC WRAP, PLANT POTS OR STYROFOAM.</b>
 <b>CARDBOARD</b>	Corrugated cardboard <b>ONLY</b> . Please break boxes down flat before placing in container.	No pizza boxes or other wax-coated cardboard.
 <b>NEWSPAPER</b>	Newspaper and inserts, magazines, office paper and junk mail.	No hardback books.
 <b>BATTERIES</b>	Only dry cell household rechargeable or one-time use batteries.	Lead-acid (car-type) batteries are accepted at the Transfer Station only.
 <b>COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS</b>	Only <b>compact</b> fluorescent lights are accepted. Place unbroken bulb in a zip-lock bag and give to site attendant.	<b>Tube-like bulbs</b> are only accepted during Household Hazardous Waste Collection.

**Only bagged household trash** is allowed in the dumpsters at the convenience centers. All other materials, including bulk waste such as yard waste, appliances, furniture, sheet rock, shingles, etc., must be taken to the Watauga County Transfer Station for disposal. County homeowners are allowed to dispose of 2000 pounds/year at no charge. **Commercial waste must be taken to the Watauga County Transfer Station.**

### ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING AT WATAUGA COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

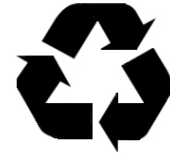
336 Landfill Rd. (Hours: M-F 8-4, Sat. 8-12)

 <b>PASTEBOARD</b>	Includes cereal, soda, beer, dry food and shoe boxes; toilet paper rolls, paper towel rolls and paper bags. <b>No</b> wax coated pasteboard such as juice and milk containers, pizza boxes or frozen food boxes. If it came out of refrigerator or freezer, it <b>CAN NOT</b> be recycled.
 <b>ELECTRONICS</b>	Includes computers and all accessories, hard drives, monitors, laptops, televisions, VCR/DVD players, phones (home and cell), fax machines, etc.
 <b>TIRES</b>	Please remove rims if possible. Tires must be neatly stacked in the trailer provided for their disposal. ( <i>No charge for tires.</i> )
 <b>SCRAP METAL &amp; "WHITE GOODS"</b>	Non-food-related scrap metal, sheet metal, lawn mowers, major appliances, bicycles, metal drums (must have a 12" hole cut in one end), etc. ( <i>No charge for "white goods".</i> )
<b>YARD WASTE</b>	Brush, grass and leaves (must not be left in bags); untreated wood and wooden pallets.

Watauga County Transfer Station **DOES NOT ACCEPT** liquids, including paint, insecticides, hazardous waste, toxic waste or gas tanks. The County provides two collection dates for household hazardous waste each year. Please call 828-265-4852 for dates. We do accept residential **used motor oil** (up to 5 gallons), **motor oil filters** and **lead-acid batteries** at the Transfer Station.
